The all-around consensus is there is a lack of housing and childcare throughout the state. Wheatland is reappointing the chair to Justin Cundall from Glendo and they are reorganizing the board. Commissioners floated the river and had good feedback for our community. Shawna will be attending the upcoming mandatory Auditor training in Cheyenne.
DEPARTMENT REPORTS: Diana Griffith with the Visitor Center thanked Mike Fronapfel for delivering her picnic table. Diana thanked CM Augustyn for helping get the grant for flowers it was so appreciated. Julie Wilkes received praise for her hard work on the weeds. Diana would like to put a plug in for Shawna Reichert on the tax board.
